**THE 2006 FIRE ARTS FESTIVAL - July 12-15**

**6<sup>th</sup> Annual Event Celebrating Fire and Light**

**with Explosive Entertainment and Exciting Arts and Educational Experiences**

**April 18, 2006, OAKLAND** – **The Crucible** will heat up the summer days and light up the Oakland nights at the **2006 Fire Arts Festival (FAF)** from **July 12-15**. Festivities take place at The Crucible's 48,000 square foot industrial arts facility and adjacent 200,000 square foot outdoor arena in West Oakland. In its sixth year, the **2006 Fire Arts Festival** will dazzle the senses with awe-inspiring fire and light sculpture and performances, as well as an extensive program of workshops, artist presentations, and arts demonstrations for adults and youth.

The festival opens on Wednesday, July 12 with the **Desert Arts Preview**, a first look at the hottest concepts from Burning Man's funded artists for 2006. Then The Crucible rolls out the red carpet on Thursday, July 13 for the "**Fire & Light**" **Benefit Auction Soiree** (\$100/members, \$125/non-members). It will be an evening of delectable delicacies, refreshing libations, sizzling performances, and a live auction of one-of-a-kind flame-wrought and fire-forged artwork from leading Bay Area artists, culminating in a procession to the Fire Arts Arena for the Opening Ceremony. The evening is a fundraiser for the non-profit's youth and adult education programs.

The weekend continues with two days of workshops, and two nights of spectacular music and fire performance in the Fire Arts Arena. Friday night's **Twisted Fiery Circus** (\$30), is an otherworldly carnival of fire, featuring the dark circus burlesque of the Yard Dogs and blazing fire performances by XENO and others. Saturday's **High Voltage Chaos** (\$30) features high-energy performances by Mutaytor and the Extra Action Marching Band, the molten sensuality of The Nekyia, and much more.

To fully enjoy all that the festival has to offer, guests can purchase a VIP All Access Pass, which provides express entry and premium access to the best the Festival has to offer (\$150/\$125 for Crucible members). VIP pass holders gain admission to all three nights, and new this year, the arena's VIP Lounge will provide an elite arena experience including hors d'oeuvres and a private bar. VIPs can also use their pass for a 10% discount on FAF or Summer Session class tuition.

This year's FAF will be presented with sponsorship from **Clear Channel, Bay City Pyrotector, BART, Cresco Rentals, the City of Oakland, the City of Oakland's Fire and Police Departments, and Lagunitas Brewing Company.**
